HOUSING

Two Bedroom Guest Apartment (on campus) – each apartment has a big living room space with kitchen (fridge, stove, oven - no cookware provided). There are two separate single/double bedrooms with one bathroom (to be shared by the two occupants of the apartment). Linen is provided including all bedding, bath towels and face cloth. Each bedroom is **\$44** with one occupant (plus 14% tax = \$50.16 per person per night).

One Bedroom Guest Apartment Living Room with kitchen, bedroom, bathroom. **\$49** (plus 14% tax = \$55.86 per night) Linen provided. (Two people sharing the bedroom are **\$34** each plus 14% tax = \$38.76)
